#### Artist Bio

Raised by a singer and a sound engineer, at 4 years old, Lilou Chance was already following the steady life of touring artists as her parents brought her to their shows. Being a very dynamic toddler, she chose to express herself through drum set playing. After some years, she started singing while playing drums and added guitars to her instruments. Multiinstrumentalist at 12, she felt the need to perform and write her own songs. After studying jazz drumming at the Paris Conservatory, she entered the American School of Modern Music in 2019 as a performer with specialization in drums and voice. She earned her diploma from the school summa cum laude in 2022. While in her senior year, she got hired as a touring drummer for the "Phénix Circus". The troupe visited all the major arenas of France and also played 50 shows in Paris. That same year, aged 20, she got endorsed by her all time favorite brands, Gretsch and Paiste. Never forgetting her dream to study in the US, she got accepted with a full tuition scholarship to Berklee College of Music. She is currently residing in Boston where she is a songwriting major at the college. During school breaks, she plays and sings at private events in Paris and Morocco. In May 2024, she played drums for the LA based artist Maris at the Boston Calling in front of a crowd of 15000 people. Recently, she performed with her own band for the Governor of Massachusetts, Maura Healey at the State house. She's set to release a newest single called "Shots" in April 2025. The song will feature her blend of neo soul and jazz influences.


